Pro Paper Scholarship	The purpose of Pro Paper Scholarship is to support high level research work and development of professional competence. The work covering the value chain of the pulp and paper industry is meant to be done at least partly abroad. The aim is to produce new knowledge, ideas and innovations.	15 October	Granted every 1-3 years in association's Autumn Meeting	Max. 50 000 € (depending on expenses)
Research Grant	Research Grant obeys the original idea of Jaakko Pöyry Fund to encourage young engineers (M.Sc.) in research work or post graduate studies. Grant can be given to a single person or a research group. One or several grants can be given at the same time.	15 October	Granted every 1-3 years at Autumn Meeting. In case the grant is not given in autumn, it can be opened for application again in spring.	Max. 5 000 € / person (depending on expenses)
Student Scholarships	The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage students of pulp and paper technology or related areas in their studies (e.g. foreign exchange or final thesis). Please note that scholarships are not granted retrospectively for expenses of previous year(s).	15 March	One or more scholarships are granted at the Annual Meeting. Can be applied one year backwards.	Max. 10 000 € / person (depending on expenses)

	Criteria	What is granted and when
Niilo Ryti Award	Given for a praiseworthy doctoral thesis made at the Laboratory of Paper Technology, Helsinki University of Technology	- Once a year at most - 5 000 €
C.J. Jansson Award	Given for a remarkable article or an original scientific essay published in a journal of the pulp&paper field. Award can also be given as a merit for work over a longer time period. Scientific as well as other articles within the field are taken into consideration.	- Amount decided by scholarship committee - Granted at Annual Meeting
Gullichsen Award	Given for a praiseworthy presentation at Johan Gullichsen Colloquium	- Granted every second year at Johan Gullichsen Colloquium - 2 000 €/presentation
Andritz Award	Award given to a praiseworthy thesis work in the field of fibre technology or its practical applications. The amount may be divided between several recipients.	- Granted in Annual Meeting - 3 000 €/person - Application deadline: 15 March
Metso Paper Mechanical Pulping Award	Award given to a praiseworthy thesis work in the field of mechanical pulp, recycled fibre, mechanical pulping technology or their practical applications. The amount may be divided between several recipients.	- Granted in Autumn Meeting - 2 000 €/person - Application deadline: 15 October

Plaquette of Merit	Awarded in recognition of outstanding work done in the association's field	Granted in Autumn Meeting (Notice: when Lampén-Medal is not given, Plaquette of Merit can also be given at Annual Meeting)
Stenbäck Plaquette	Awarded in recognition of outstanding work done on behalf of the association	Granted at Autumn Meeting
